Skills Refresher If it's been a while since you last dived, or perhaps you are planning a holiday overseas and feel you need to brush up on your skills a Skills Refresher evening is just what you need. During this pool based session, we will take you through the 18 basic skills which you would have learnt when you first learnt to dive. We can tailor make your refresher evening to suit the skills that you want to practice.

ADVENTURE



The **PADI Adventure Diver** allows PADI Open Water divers (or equivalent) to take part in supervised dives in new or unfamiliar surroundings, for example Boat Dive, Dry suit Dive, Underwater Naturalist or Drift Dive. A diver who completes any three Adventure Dives earns the PADI Adventure Diver rating.

Each adventure dive may be counted as the first dive of the related PADI Specialty Diver. A diver who completes the Deep Dive, the Underwater Navigation Dive and three additional Adventure Dives earns the Advanced Open Water Diver certification.

EXPERIENCE

The **PADI Advanced Open Water Diver Course** builds upon the skills acquired in the Open Water Course, enhancing navigation and introducing deeper diving, to a maximum of 30 metres (100 feet). The course consists of 5 open water dives - 2 core dives (Underwater Navigation Dive and a Deep Dive) and 3 adventure dives - with course content tailored to the type of diving that is being undertaken.

The 3 adventure dives could include a Night Dive, Boat Dive, Wreck Dive, Underwater Naturalist Dive, Drift Dive, Dry Suit Dive, Peak Performance Buoyancy or Search and Recovery Dive. The course typically takes place over two days.

The aim is to greatly enhance your confidence and knowledge of scuba diving. The course is a 'hands-on' experience; there is some theory but the principal focus of the Advanced Open Water is to introduce you to new diving experiences and adventures!

The Course fee includes manual, data slate, diver's log, tuition as above and certification card on successful completion of the course. It also includes entry / boat fees and equipment hire. We recommend that divers own their own masks fins and snorkel by this stage, although it is not a pre-requisite.

If you've already gained any Adventure Dives you are already on your way as you can count them towards your Advanced Open Water qualification.



CONFIDENCE

The **PADI Rescue Diver Course** is an important step in increasing a diver's knowledge and abilities beyond those of a basic recreational diver. The course fine-tunes your ability to prevent problems and teaches and develops the necessary knowledge and skills for divers to provide effective assistance to others, to effectively perform diver rescues, to manage diving accident situations and to administer appropriate first aid.

The Rescue Diver course is conducted over 4 days and is a challenging and rewarding experience. It is regarded by many students and instructors to be the most enjoyable and stimulating of all the PADI courses.

To take part in the PADI Rescue Diver course you must be a qualified PADI Advanced Open Water Diver or equivalent and be 12 yrs old. To be certified as a PADI Rescue Diver you must have successfully completed a sanctioned course in CPR within the past two years. The Emergency First Response course is highly recommended.

The Course fee includes manual, work slate, tuition as above, use of equipment if required and certification card upon successful completion of the course.

What now . . .

You need to be:

Skills Refresher: the PADI Open Water Diver qualification or equivalent

PADI Adventure Diver and PADI Advanced Open Water Course: the PADI Open Water Diver qualification, *or an equivalent rating (e.g. BSAC Sport Diver)*, and a reasonable level of fitness (see medical questionnaire).

PADI Rescue Diver Course are: the PADI Advanced Open Water qualification, *or an equivalent rating with a minimum of 20 logged dives (e.g. BSAC Sport Diver)*, a first aid certification including CPR (PADI Medic First Aid recommended) and a reasonable level of fitness (see medical questionnaire).

Minimum age:

PADI Adventure Diver, Advanced Open Water or Rescue Diver: Min age: 15 yrs. Junior 12 yrs.

How to book:

PADI Adventure Diver, Advanced Open Water Diver or Rescue Diver: Return a completed Scuba Diving Course Booking Form, Medical Statement and 50% deposit.

Payment

Minimally we ask for 50% of the course fee to secure the booking with the final payment being paid on completion of the course.
