

So You Want To Learn To Scuba Dive?

Learning to scuba dive is easier than most people imagine, all you need is enthusiasm, the ability to swim and average fitness.

Depending on what you want from your scuba diving there are *three options* in how you learn to dive - you can participate in an introductory experience, undertake part of the course in the UK and finish it on holiday abroad or complete the entire course here in Bristol or Swindon. The choice is yours!

Test the water with a 'Discover Scuba Dive'! If you have never experienced the awesome feeling of breathing underwater we suggest 'Discover Scuba Diving'.

This introduces you to the basic equipment and skills involved in scuba diving and gives you your very first scuba diving experience in a swimming pool.



The 'Discover Scuba Diving' involves some basic verbal theory on what to do and what not to do and gives you approximately 60 minutes of in water enjoyment. The cost of this much fun? Only **£25**. (discounts for groups of 4 or more)

All you will need is a swimming costume and some enthusiasm - we supply the rest.

If you have your own pool then we can supply equipment and staff for a pool party with an added dimension - you can really give your friends a memorable experience!



Option 1

The **PADI Open Water Diver Course** is your first full scuba qualification which enables you to dive to 18 metres (60 feet) with a qualified buddy, enables you to buy and hire diving equipment and purchase diving services such as air fills and diving trips on dive boats.

The course consists of 2 theory sessions, 4 pool sessions and 4 open water dives. Due to the modular nature of the course it is possible to conduct the course over a period of weeks.

As the course is conducted in the UK we want to ensure that you are properly equipped. Consequently we complete all our training in dry suits. These special exposure suits protect you from the cold, regardless of the water temperature.

Our aim is to produce properly trained, confident divers who are ready to continue with their diving experiences. As a result we always teach in the sea (weather permitting) and have a club for you to join once you're certified!

All of our prices include everything you need to complete the course. You just need to turn up! We also only ever teach one-on-one in Open Water! **One Professional for every student!**

Option 2

The **PADI Open Water Referral** is aimed at divers wanting to do the PADI Open Water Course academic and pool training here in the UK and then complete their 4 open water dives at another PADI Dive Centre, typically abroad on holiday – this frees the rest of the holiday allowing you to get down to some serious diving, rather than spending it in a classroom.



Again; our price is inclusive of everything you need to complete the referral course. You can also upgrade from the PADI Open Water Referral which includes four dives and equipment hire (manual not included). Maybe you're a qualified diver who hasn't dived for a while. Our **Refresher Session** may be just what you are looking for. We will cater the pool session to your requirements from putting equipment together to refreshing your scuba diving skills and being able to move in 3 dimensions. Perfect at only **£30** per session

What now . . .

You need to be able to:

Discover Scuba: have the ability to swim. PADI Open Water course: reasonable health (see Medical Statement), the ability to swim 200m or snorkel 300m, and to tread water for 10 minutes.

Minimum age:

Discover Scuba: 8 yrs (however this is dependent on equipment sizing).

PADI Open Water course: 15 yrs, or for the Junior Rating: 10 yrs (this is subject to build and equipment sizes!).

How to book:

DSD: Return a completed Discover Scuba Booking Form, Medical Statement and payment of £25. PADI Open Water course: Return a completed Booking Form, Medical Statement and 50% deposit, with the balance payable one week prior to the course start.

Course Dates:

When we have received your booking we will confirm your course dates with you in writing. Please feel free to contact us to anytime prior to the course starting should you have any questions. All materials will be given to you prior to the course starting so you have plenty of time to read through all of the training material.

Payment

Minimally we ask for 50% of the course fee to secure the booking with the final payment being paid on completion of the course.
