


Scuba diving is an exciting, dynamic recreation that supports a growing worldwide industry with many professional opportunities. A scuba diving career can break you out of a nine-to-five office job, or provide you with an enjoyable part-time vocation.

Like many divers, you may envy the lifestyle of the dive professionals you know – they get paid to go diving, to travel, and to introduce people to an exciting recreational activity. Best of all, they have a job they love, doing for a living what you do for fun. Pursuing a professional diving career can be rewarding and lucrative.



There are more than 3,500 PADI Dive Centres and Resorts around the world. At any given time, there are more job vacancies available for PADI Professionals than there are professionals to fill them. Whatever diving career you choose, earning a professional PADI credential will get you where you want to go.

 **PADI Divemaster - the first Professional qualification**

The qualification of PADI Divemaster signifies a diver who has attained a high degree of excellence in diving theory and diving practice. It is the first professional PADI qualification and permits the qualified diver to act in a supervisory capacity, to be an instructional assistant and to act as an underwater guide.

The course builds an in depth knowledge of diving theory and student awareness, fine tunes in-water skills, includes rescue, navigation and mapping exercises, as well as confined and open water training in all aspects of student supervision.

The course is typically conducted on an 'intern' basis where you attend and assist with evening and weekend pool, theory and open water training over a period of weeks.

Cost of the PADI Divemaster Course includes Crew Pack, Diver Knowledge Workbook and tuition as above. Professional Membership of PADI is by student application on successful completion of the course.*

PADI Assistant Instructor - Practical experience for future instructors

PADI Assistant Instructors are dive educators who assist with, organise and supervise knowledge development, confined water and open water activities.

Assistant Instructors work in partnership with PADI Instructors to provide student divers with quality knowledge and skill development during PADI programmes.



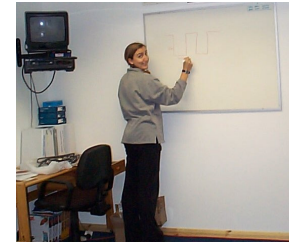
The teaching skills Assistant Instructors develop during their training allows them to independently conduct several PADI programmes, and with

further training they may also teach non-diving specialty courses.

The PADI Assistant Instructor course is divided into three modules; Academic Training, Independent Study and Practical Application.

The PADI Assistant Instructor certification can be credited towards the PADI Instructor

Development Course, reducing the length of the IDC by approximately 4 days.



Cost of the PADI Assistant Instructor Course includes Candidate Workbook and tuition as above. Professional Membership of PADI is by student application on successful completion of the course.*

PADI Instructor Development Course – the full Monty!



The PADI IDC is typically a 7 day course which is divided in two sections. The first section (AI) is the Assistant Instructor course as above. The second section (OWSI) continues to develop your knowledge and instructing abilities and develops your theory in areas such as business principles, legal responsibility and risk management. If you are already an AI you can simply take part in the OWSI section.

Upon successful completion of the IDC candidates can enrol on a PADI IE which is a 2 day assessment of your knowledge, teaching and watermanship skills.*

* To successfully complete these courses candidates will need to have copies of the following PADI reference books and materials: The Encyclopaedia of Recreational Diving, Best of the Undersea Journal, The Business of Diving, The Law and the Diving Professional, PADI RDP Wheel and PADI RDP Table.

You should also be in a position where you own all of your own diving equipment.

What now . . .

To enrol:

PADI Divemaster course: minimum of 20 logged dives, PADI Rescue Diver certification, current first aid certification that includes CPR (Emergency First Response recommended) and submit medical clearance for diving signed by a physician within the previous 12 months.

PADI Assistant Instructor course and IDC: Be a PADI Divemaster or leadership level with another diver training organisation; submit medical clearance for diving signed by a physician within the previous 12 months. Submit documentation of CPR and First Aid training within the last 24 months. Have completed 60 logged dives (showing experience in night, deep and underwater navigation diving), successfully complete a knowledge and skill pre-assessment (complete the PADI Divemaster dive rescue assessment if crossing over from another organisation).

To certify

Successfully complete your chosen course. For the Divemaster you will need to have obtained 60 logged dives by the end of the course. On successful completion of the PADI IDC, candidates must have proof of 100 logged dives before enrolling on an IE.

The minimum age is 18.

How to book

Complete a Booking Form, Medical Statement and 50% deposit.

Payment

Minimally we ask for 50% of the course fee to secure the booking with the final payment being paid on completion of the course.

When we have received your booking form we will confirm your course start date and schedules.
